Category 5

Children with a normal home address within the ecclesiastical parish of Earley St Peter's Church, one of whose parents is a regular worshipper at Earley St Peter's Church (at least once a month for at least the 12 months preceding the application date).

In order for an application to be considered under this criterion the parent must complete the school's Church attendance form (countersigned by the relevant Minister) and send this form directly to the School.

For those who have recently moved into the area and are attending Earley St. Peter's Church, worship prior to the move at their previous Anglican church will be taken into account (so the total qualifying period will be regular worship at least once a month for at least 12 months prior to the application date). The parent will also be required to provide a church attendance form, countersigned by the relevant Minister of the previous church, with their application.

In the event that during the period specified for attendance at worship the church has been closed for public worship and has not provided alternative premises for that worship, the requirements of these arrangements in relation to attendance will only apply to the period when the church or alternative premises have been available for public worship
