KS2 Job Description

A classroom teacher will be responsible for the following main tasks:

- To carry out duties of a school teacher as set out in the current School
 Teachers' Pay and Conditions Document and ensure that the Teachers' Standards are met.
- 2. To share responsibility for the welfare and safety of all the children in the care of the school.
- 3. To be an effective, successful and creative teacher catering for the needs of the children in the class.
- 4. To teach within the framework of the school policies.
- 5. To plan and prepare short, medium and long term work for the children and to attend planning meetings.
- 6. To plan and resource a classroom environment that will stimulate learning.
- 7. To establish and maintain good relationships with children, parents and colleagues in line with the principles of inclusion.
- 8. To monitor children's progress, keep meaningful records and evaluate progress and performance.
- 9. To attend parents' meetings, giving feedback and setting targets with parents.
- 10. To accept responsibility with other members of staff for implementing school activities in accordance with school policy.
- 11. To accept responsibility for the development and leadership of a curriculum area.
- 12. To recognise the individual needs of each child within the class.
- 13. To keep abreast of current educational initiatives.
- 14. To implement the school's safeguarding practices and policies.
- 15. To undertake any other suitable duties that the Headteacher may require from time to time.
